

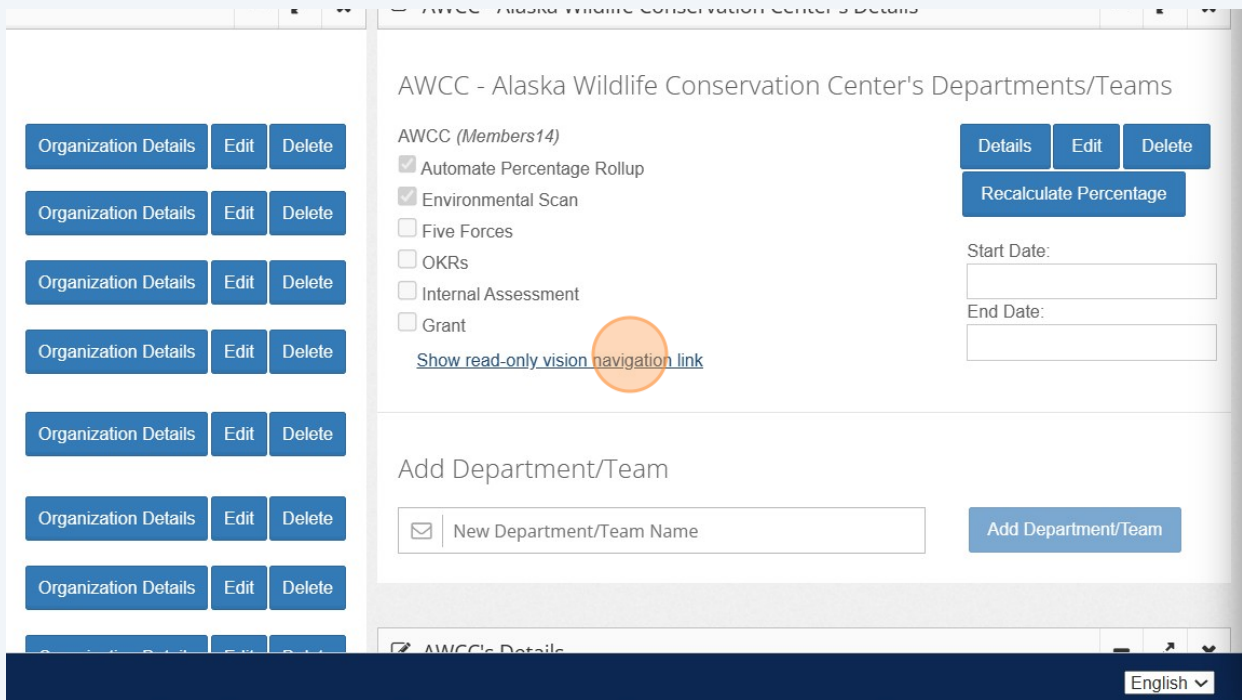
# How to Access Read-Only Vision Navigation Link
